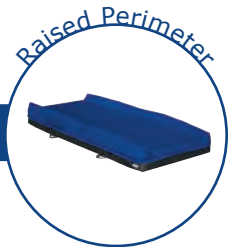
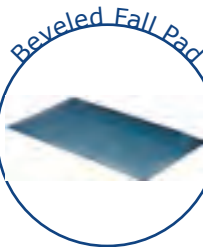
JCAHO 2007 National Patient Safety Goals*

- Goal 9** *Reduce the risk of patient harm resulting from falls.*
9B *Implement a fall reduction program including an evaluation of the effectiveness of the program.*

- Reduce injuries resulting from falls
- Address JCAHO Patient Safety Goals
 - Reduce Sitter Costs

High-Low Bed

- 8 ¾" low and 34" high; reduce falls and the incidence of work related back injury.
- Molded quad rail design meets all new FDA guidelines for entrapment zones.
- Central steering system.
- Integrated nurse call button.
- Footboard, siderail, and hand-held controls.
- Exit alarm and fall pad.
- Patient can control only what the staff allows via the lockout on the footboard control panel.

Enclosure Bed Canopy
